The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.236 dated 29.11.2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 307, 326, 353, 166, 323, 34 of Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC') (challan presented under Section 325, 333, 353, 186, 323, 34 IPC) at Police Station City South Moga, District Moga.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is in custody since 30th November, 2017 and nothing is to be recovered from her.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Sonia wife of Davinder Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned subject to following terms:-

(a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.

(b) In the event of her absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel her bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure her presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.

(c) She shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
