MAIN CASE

Present petition is for issuing direction to the respondents for fair investigation in the matter after registration of cross case in view of statement/complaint dated 17.12.2017 (Annexure P-1) recorded by

CRM-M No.9150 of 2018 (O&M)

Investigating Officer in PGIMS, Rohtak with regard to multiple injuries inflicted on the person of the petitioner in the occurrence wherein FIR No.816 dated 13.12.2017, under Sections 323, 307, 506, 34 IPC and 27 of Arms Act, Police Station Sonapat City, District Sonapat (Annexure P-2) has been registered against the petitioner and his other family members.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has also received injuries in the fight. The other party was the aggressive party, but despite that FIR has been registered against the petitioner along with her husband and others. She asserts that the petitioner had been approaching the authorities for redressal of their grievances and in support thereof she has referred to representation which has been entrusted to the authorities, copies thereof has been appended as Annexure P-4 (colly). Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if direction is issued to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Sonapat to look into the representation (P-4) of the petitioner and take appropriate action in accordance with law.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Sonapat to consider the representation dated 21.12.2017 (Annexure P-4 colly) and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law, if required.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
