Present petition has been filed for seeking the police security to the petitioner in view of the threat perception as well as on account of elimination of his minor son-Abhishek Tyagi.

In pursuance of the notice of motion, issued by this Court, affidavit dated 14.11.2018 of Sh. K.K.Rao, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Gurugram has been filed in the Registry of this Court. The same is taken on record.

Paragraph 7 of the aforesaid affidavit reads as follows:-

“ That as per the information obtained from the Deputy Commissioner of Police, East, Gurugram, no fresh threat perception has been found to be received by the petitioner as he has neither submitted an application nor he has got registered any FIR regarding threat. However, the DCP East has recommended to continue the police protection to the petitioner

on payment, as per rules and instructions from the Government. Although the petitioner had deposited the payment upto 30.09.2018. However, keeping in view the protection of the petitioner, one Ct. Somdutt No.3583/GGM has been provided as Gunman to the petitioner with arms for 24 hours, against payment, vide DD No.18 dated 02.10.2018, by the Gurugram Police.”

In view of the stand taken by the respondents, learned Counsel for the petitioner is satisfied and states that the present petition be disposed off at this stage.

Ordered accordingly.
