The petitioners seek directions to the official respondents for protecting their life and liberty and that of their families at the hands of private respondents.

The allegations made in the petition are that respondents No. 4 to 12 have encroached upon public land and have dug a pit for storing cow dung in which water is poured from time to time resulting in foul smell. Representations have been made by the petitioners but no action is being taken thereupon. Final representation dated 26.12.2017 (Annexure P-3) has been placed on record.

The submission is that the community of the petitioners is in minority and they are being threatened by the private respondents and members of their community for trying to oppose them.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3.

Mr. Nishchal Mann, DAG Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3. Let four copies of petition be supplied to him by tomorrow.

In view of the nature of order that is being passed there is no necessity to issue notice to private respondents No. 4 to 12 at this stage.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is

disposed of with directions to respondent No. 3 to consider the allegations made in

the representation (Annexure P-3) and to take appropriate action in accordance with law as deemed fit within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
