The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of interim bail till receipt of report of chemical examiner in case FIR No. 57, dated 23.10.2017, registered under Sections 392, 384, 382, 506, 148, 149, 120-B IPC and 18, 22 and 29 of NDPS Act and Section 25 of Arms Act, at Police Station Sadar Rajpura, District Patiala.

Learned State counsel has placed on record a copy of FSL report. As per FSL report, the recovery from the petitioner was commercial.

In compliance of order dated 20.03.2018, the petitioner has already surrendered on 03.04.2018 before the Court below. Application for regular bail has already been dismissed.

As it is a case of commercial quantity, provisions of Section 37 of the NDPS Act are applicable to the applicant.

In view of above, no case is made out for regular bail.
