Affidavit of Assistant Inspector General of Police, Litigation, Bureau of Investigation, Punjab, Chandigarh, in compliance with the order dated 26.04.2018/14.05.2018, has been filed in Court, taken on record, according to which approval has been granted by the Director, Bureau of Investigation, Punjab, Chandigarh, to present a report under Section 173 (2) Cr.P.C. in Court against the accused for commission of offence under Sections 324, 323, 326, 307, 148, 149, 34 of IPC.
