Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.122 dated 19.12.2016 under Sections 307, 326, 324, 323, 506 and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Lahori Gate, Patiala (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard at length.

The FIR was registered on the statement of complainant-Sarabjeet Singh @ Kinni in relation to an alleged occurrence dated 19.12.2016.

Insofar as the present petitioner is concerned, there are specific attribution of having inflicted four knife blows on the person of Harwinder Singh @ Happy i.e. on his chest, one blow near the testicle and one on the left leg, as also on the left arm. Furthermore, the petitioner has even inflicted blows on the right side of the thigh of the complainant and on the left buttock of one Amandeep Singh @ Avni.

The injuries attributed to the petitioner find corroboration from the medical record which has been made available by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Hardeep Singh, Police Station Lahori Gate, Patiala.

Against the backdrop of serious allegations and gravity of offence, this Court is not inclined to extend the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Petition dismissed at this stage.
