This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking pre-arrest bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Sections 147, 149, 342, 384 & 506 IPC at Police Station, City Karnal, District, Karnal vide F.I.R No. 1167 dated 8.11.2017.

Learned State counsel submits that pursuant to order dated 4.1.2018, petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation. The court has also been apprised by counsel for the petitioner as well counsel representing the complainant that there is possibility of amicable settlement of the dispute.
