Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.08 dated 13.6.2017, registered under Sections 420, 120-B IPC and Section 66 of the Information Technology Act, at P.S. State Cyber Crime, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

In pith and substance, the allegations against the petitioner are for the offences under Sections 420/120-B IPC and 66-D of the Information Technology Act. Offence under Section 66-D of the Information Technology Act is bailable.

Complainant alleges that he had developed a product in the name of Divya Kit and has been selling the same on website and by advertising on various news channels. The product Divya Kit is registered by the complainant in his name. Allegation against the company of the accused is that the product of the complainant has been fraudulently used by the company of the accused in terms of its identity and they are selling their own similar product in the name of product of the complainant. In this manner, the complainant has been cheated by the petitioner as well as by his other co-accused by misusing the internet and have made wrongful gain by uploading false and wrong information on the internet.

The petitioner was subjected to interrogation by taking remand from the Court and now he is in judicial custody. The offence is triable by Magistrate. Petitioner is in custody since 1.12.2017.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Daljit Singh, submits that the challan is almost ready qua the petitioner and is likely to be filed in the Court.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, this petition is allowed. Let the petitioner be enlarged on bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail

bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial
Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate, SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be
an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
