This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.124 dated 11.5.2017 under sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Division No.5, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

Allegations against the petitioner are that he was in connivance with other co-accused and having made an attempt to usurp the property of the complainant.

Petitioner was arrested on 29.9.2017.

It has gone uncontroverted that co-accused Harpreet Singh Dimple and Deepak Arora have been granted benefit of regular bail by this Court.

Investigation in the case is complete and the challan has been presented. Trial is at the initial stage and would take time to conclude.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Petition disposed of.
