Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for issuance of direction to the respondents not to harass the petitioner as no criminal case is pending against him. It is also prayed that notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. be given in case the petitioner is required for any investigation.

2. The allegations in the petition are that although there is no criminal case registered against the petitioner, he is being harassed by the Police for reasons best known to it. Even his wife and minor children are threatened in his absence and a sum of Rupees one lac is being demanded to settle the matter (although there is no pending case before the Police). A representation dated 24-02-2018 (Annexure P-1), has already been made in this regard but harassment has not stopped.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Let six copies of petition be supplied to him during the

course of the day.

5. In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity of calling for a counter from the respondents.

6. The petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.3 to carefully scrutinize the allegations made in the representation dated 24.02.2018 (Annexure P-1), and to take appropriate action, if deemed necessary, within a period of two weeks' from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
