This is petition filed by the petitioner for direction to respondents No. 1 to 5 to look into his representation.

Learned State counsel submits that the challan has been filed in this case and representation of the petitioner has already been looked into by Vigilance Bureau, which was found to be false.

Keeping in view that representation of petitioner has been considered by respondents and challan has been filed, this petition is rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner be permitted to raise the pleas taken in this petition before trial Court. Request of learned counsel for the petitioner is allowed and petition is ordered be dismissed.

It is, however, made clear that anything observed in this order regarding the plea taken by the petitioner in this petition will not come in his way at the time of framing of charge or in availing any other legal remedies.
