This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.565 dated 1.10.2017 under sections 307, 148, 149, 506 I.P.C, section 25 of Arms Act and section 3(1) V SC/ST Act (sections 427, 323, 325, 120-B I.P.C were added later on) registered at Police Station, Sadar Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

Petitioner was arrested on 1.10.2017.

Concededly it is a case of no injury.

It has also gone uncontroverted that material witness i.e. complainant as also other eye witnesses have not supported the prosecution version.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
