Petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No.74 dated 18.05.2017, under Sections 354, 323, 34 IPC, registered at Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran.

It is submitted that the petitioners have been falsely implicated primarily due to a dispute regarding parking of motorcycles in the street near the complainant's house. The unexplained delay of three days in lodging of the FIR further reflects on the falsity of the same. Moreover, the petitioners have joined investigation. It is thus prayed that this petition be allowed.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Rasal Singh, verifies that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not involved in any other criminal case.

There are no allegations on behalf of the State that the petitioners are likely to abscond or that they likely to dissuade the witnesses from deposing true facts in the Court, if released on anticipatory bail.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as above, but

without commenting upon or expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed. Consequently, order dated 07.03.2018, is made absolute.

Petitioners shall not attempt to contact the complainant/ witnesses in any manner directly or indirectly. Any such infraction shall entail cancellation of bail afforded to them.

It is clarified that none of the observations made hereinabove shall be construed to be a reflection on the merits of the case. The same are solely confined for the purpose of decision of the present petition.
