The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.10 dated 13.01.2017, registered under Sections 457, 380, 427, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, 34 IPC (Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC added later) at Police Station Jamalpur in Police Commissionerate of District Ludhiana.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 08.03.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
