In respect of the grievance of the petitioners, they are stated to have made a representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Jalandhar (respondent no. 2), on 02.03.2018, (a copy of which has been annexed as Annexure P-4 with the petition), before which a representation was also made to the Station House Officer on 28.02.2018 (a copy of which has been annexed as Annexure P-3 with the petition).

Learned counsel further points to the fact that the civil suit filed by respondents no. 4 to 7 against the petitioners' father, seeking a decree of permanent injunction, was dismissed by the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Phillaur, vide his order dated 21.08.2015 (a copy of which has been annexed as Annexure P-1 with the petition), with the appeal filed by the respondent still pending before the appellate Court, but with no interim order passed by that Court in favour of the appellants-plaintiffs, i.e. respondents no. 4 to 7.

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Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police (respondent no. 2) to go into the matter and to take action, as warranted as per law, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
