The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No. 12 dated 14.02.2018 under Sections 498-A, 406 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sandaur, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has complied with the order dated 08.03.2018 and have deposited his passport with the Investigating Officer. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from him.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not

required for the custodial interrogation while submitting that the petitioner has deposited his passport with the Investigating Officer.

In view of the facts that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation and has joined the investigation and also have submitted his passport, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 08.03.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
