The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for grant of concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.86 dated 24.05.2017, under Sections 22, 61, 85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that on account of the wrong date, communicated by learned Counsel appearing before the trial Court, the petitioner could not appear on 07.02.2018 before learned Special Judge, Jalandhar and due to that reason, bail bonds and surety bonds stood cancelled and forfeited. It is further contended that the petitioner is ready to join the proceedings and will not escape in future.

In view of above, the petitioner is directed to surrender before learned trial Court and in case he does so, he shall be released on bail by learned trial Court on his furnishing fresh bail bonds and surety bonds to its satisfaction.

Disposed off accordingly.
