CM No.2053-CI of 2016

Application has been filed for bringing on record legal representatives of deceased respondent Nos.1 and 2 Amarjit Singh and Balbir Kaur, who have expired on 05.02.1994 and 11.06.2013 respectively during the pendency of the proceedings. It has been averred that the sole legal representatives of the deceased respondents are mentioned in para No.3 of the application. Accordingly, the application, duly supported by an affidavit of Amarjit Kaur widow of deceased respondent No.1 Amarjit Singh, is allowed and the said legal heirs are brought on record to pursue the present appeal only. It is made clear that

this order shall not be liable to be taken into consideration in any other set of proceedings.

CM stands disposed of.

Main case

The appeal is dismissed. However, the cross objections of the respondent/land-owners are partly allowed to the extent that land owners are entitled to uniform compensation of Rs.7,20,000/- per acre alongwith all statutory benefits.
