Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing complaint bearing No.RT 183/16.09.2002, dated 11.09.2001(Annexure P-1), under Sections 307/392/450/427/440/148/149 IPC and 25/27 of Arms Act, and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-3).

Vide order dated 09.03.2018, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate to get their statements recorded for alleged compromise between them. However, they did not appear. Consequently, on repeated requests of learned counsel for the petitioner, two more opportunities were afforded to them for the said purpose vide orders dated 03.07.2018 and 14.08.2018. Despite that, they have not done the needful.

Consequently, it is evident that there is no compromise as alleged between the parties.

Dismissed for want of prosecution.
