**AMOL RATTAN SINGH, J.(ORAL)**

Learned counsel for the State has produced in Court today a signed statement (in Hindi). The statement is shown to be signed by the complainant, Pawan Kumar, as also 6 other persons, giving details of the allegations made against the petitioner, also stating therein that certain evidence has been collected by them against the petitioner and those stated to be indulging in illegal activities, due to which the deceased is alleged to have committed suicide.

However, as per the said signed statement, such evidence would be given by them only to the Court.

That being so, this petition is disposed of with the order dated 08.03.2018 made absolute, but with no comment made by this Court whatsoever, on the actual culpability or otherwise of the petitioner and any

other person alleged to be involved in the suicide committed by the deceased, all of which would be gone into by the investigating agency, and the competent Court at the appropriate stage.

If of course the investigating agency is not conducting the investigation in a proper manner as has been alleged by the complainant, he would obviously be at liberty to take appropriate legal action with regard thereto.
