The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.166, dated 17.09.2017 registered under Sections 452, 323, 324, 326, 307/34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Division No.3, District Jalandhar.

2. The petitioner was arrested on 13th October, 2017.
3. After completion of investigation trial in the case has commenced by way of framing of charges although prosecution evidence is yet to start.
4. It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the dispute has been amicably compromised with the complainant as well as the injured-victim.
5. Be that as it may, further detention of the petitioner for an indefinite period at this stage is not justified. He may therefore be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court concerned.
