Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 99 dated 1.12.2017, registered under Sections 363, 366-A, 120-B IPC with enhanced offences under Section 376 IPC and Section 5, 6 and 11 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, Police Station Joga, District Mansa.
