It is inter alia contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that a complaint was submitted against them by the private respondents and pursuant thereto, the petitioners have already got recorded their statements before respondent No.3 as well as before respondent No.4, yet they are being harassed by respondent No.4. A representation dated 01.03.2018 (Annexure P-2) has been submitted in this regard, but no action is being taken thereupon.

Notice of motion. Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Let six copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to call upon respondents No.6 to 8, at this stage.

The petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.3 to look into the allegations made in representation dated 01.03.2018 (Annexure P-2) and take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
