Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.11 dated 14.01.2018 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, Sections 61/1/14 of Excise Act and Sections 63/64 of the Copyright Act, registered at Police Station Adampur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the order dated 08.03.2018, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Ashok Kumar, who is present in the Court, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 08.03.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
