Petitioners have sought for quashing of FIR No.253 dated 15.07.2015 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Jodhewal, District Ludhiana, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-3).

2. Parties have entered into a compromise vide Annexure P-3. This Court by order dated 09.03.2018 directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate for recording their statements with regard to veracity of compromise. It has been recorded by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana and a report in this regard has been sent to this Court vide letter dated 11.05.2018.

3. In view of the law laid down in Narinder Singh v. State of Punjab; 2014 (6) SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.253 dated 15.07.2015 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Jodhewal, District Ludhiana alongwith all consequential proceeding arising out of this FIR are hereby quashed only

qua the petitioner subject to payment of litigation cost of Rs.5000/- by the petitioner to the Home Department of State of Punjab within a period of 2 months from today.
