Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (in short 'Cr.P.C.') in FIR No. 156 dated 28.12.2016 for offences under Sections 326, 324, 341 of IPC, registered at Police Station Kot Ise Khan, District Moga.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that as per allegation in the FIR, the petitioner is attributed an injury on the left leg of complainant- Amandeep Singh @ Vicky. It is further submitted that the petitioner is in judicial lock up since 23.01.2018 and is no more required for further investigation.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate dated 13.03.2018 and as per this certificate, the petitioner is in judicial lock since 23.01.2018. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Major Singh, has further submitted that the investigation is complete and the challan is likely to be presented very soon.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case and considering the fact that the investigation, against the petitioner, is complete

and he is no more required for further investigation; petitioner is in judicial lock up since 23.01.2018; the offences are triable by the Court of Magistrate and it will take long time to conclude the trial, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate.

However, it will be open for the prosecution to apply for cancellation of bail, if the petitioner is found involved misusing the concession of bail, in any manner .
