The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.10 dated 13.01.2017, registered under Sections 457, 380, 427, 34 and Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC (added later on), at Police Station Jamalpur, Ludhiana.

The allegations against the petitioner is that the complainant purchased a plot for construction and the petitioner alongwith her associates demolished the four walls of the construction of the said plot and civil suit regarding the said plot is pending.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Subhash Rai, has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation, nothing is to be recovered from her and she is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 09.03.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
