The petitioner prays for issuing directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to complete investigation in case FIR No. 265 dated 11.10.2014 registered at Police Station City Jagraon under Sections 420, 406, 120-B IPC.

It is contended that the private respondents had taken money from the petitioner for sending him abroad but they did not do so and, therefore, FIR No. 265 dated 11.10.2014 was registered against him. Despite that, the investigation has not been progressed. The money of the petitioner has also not been recovered till date.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3. Let four copies of petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of order that is being passed there is no necessity to issue notice to private respondents No. 4 to 6 at this stage.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to complete the investigation

in FIR No. 265 dated 11.10.2014 registered at Police Station City Jagraon under

Sections 420, 406, 120-B IPC expeditiously and in any case not later than four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
