Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that in respect of harassment meted to the petitioners by their own children, the petitioners ventured to file CRM-M No.17672 of 2017, which was disposed of on 13.09.2017 with a liberty to approach the District Magistrate/Deputy Commissioner for seeking appropriate relief under the relevant statute. Thereafter, petitioners filed application before Deputy Commissioner on 18.09.2017, but till date, no action has been taken by respondent No.2, despite reminder issued by the petitioners on 22.01.2018.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Let requisite copies of petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioners during course of the day.

At this stage, this petition can be disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to decide the pending application in accordance with law within reasonable time.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
