Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of order dated 09.03.2018, the petitioner has joined the investigation and this fact has been affirmed by learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Raj Kumar.

It has been mentioned in the order dated 02.05.2018 that the petitioner is involved in another FIR of similar nature and the learned State counsel was directed to place on record the copy of FIR.

Learned State counsel submits that three FIRs bearing No. **186 dated 04.09.2015**, 305 dated 19.12.2012 and **FIR No.92 dated 17.05.2015** were registered against the petitioner and in all these cases, he has been discharged.

In view of the above, the interim order passed in favour of the petitioner on 09.03.2018 is made absolute.
