Civil Misc. Application No. 6188 of 2018 has been moved for release of the remaining amount which was retained in the FDR during the course of the proceedings. On an earlier occasion under the orders of this Court an amount of Rs. 2,91,82,200/- was released. The petitioner has prayed that the remaining amount be also released alongwith interest that has accrued thereon. It is further stated that the amount due to the Administration has already been paid.

Civil Misc.application is allowed. The remaining amount which is now with the bank in shape of FDR be also released forthwith alongwith interest that has accrued thereon to settle the matter in entirety.

Having regard to the fact that the issue has now been settled and the interest of the Administration has been adequately secured with the

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complete payment of the lease amount, the contro versy raised in the present petition has been rendered infructuous. Therefore, the present Civil Misc. application No.6189 of 2018 is allowed. The present petition is disposed of as such.
