This is a petition that has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to safeguard the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent No.3, who has been harassed and pressurized at the hands of respondent No.3 to compromise the matter with respondents No.4 to 8.

Notice of motion was issued in the matter, in response to which a reply has been filed by the respondent-State, in which it is stated that after the registration of the case, the matter was investigated and all allegations as set out by the petitioner were found to be false. The enquiry officer has recommended that a cancellation report be filed in the case and on the basis of which, concerned SHO has prepared a cancellation report on 18.08.2018 and the same would be presented in the court, after its acceptance by the

concerned SSP.

On this, learned counsel for the petitioner-complainant submits that in case, such a cancellation report is filed, the petitioner-complainant be given liberty to file a protest petition thereto.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties, apart from perusing the record.

In view of the reply filed, no further orders are called.

Disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous, while giving liberty to the petitioner-complainant to file a protest petition, in case, a cancellation report is filed in the matter.
