In this petition, the petitioner seeks her release on anticipatory bail. She had been summoned to face trial in case Criminal Complaint No.04-I dated 20.02.2017 under Sections 420, 467, 468 & 471 of the IPC pending in the Court of Ld. Judicial Magistrate First Class, Hisar. She first approached the Court of Sessions for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C., and was favoured with protection subject to surrendering before the Ld. Trial Court within 15 days from 14.12.2017.

[2]. However, she was unable to appear in compliance of the aforesaid order, and claims that the disability was on account of her on going treatment for “Tubercular Pleural Effusion”, and therefore, approached the Court of Sessions for extension of time, which prayer was, however, rejected. She is, therefore, approached this Court for release on an anticipatory bail.

[3]. In view of the grounds made out in the petition, and considering that the petitioner was already directed to be released earlier,

there does not appear to be any need to notify even the respondent/complainant.

[4]. The present petition is disposed off with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the Ld. Trial Court within 10 days from today after which she may be released on the same terms as were directed by the Ld. Additional Sessions Judge, Hisar, in her Bail Application No.316-BA of 2017.

[5]. However, she shall also pay costs amounting to ₹5,000/- to the complainant for the delay which has been occasioned in the matter which payment shall be a condition precedent for her release on bail.
