Prayer in CRM No.3432 of 2018 is for compounding of the offence as the matter has been compromised between the parties vide compromise deed dated 25.01.2018.

Counsel for the complainant states that the matter having been amicably resolved and there being a compromise between the parties, the complainant has no objection in case the offence is compounded.

In view of the fact that the matter has been amicably resolved and there is a compromise between the parties, the present application as also the revision petition is allowed.

The offence stands compounded.

Conviction and sentence of the petitioner as imposed by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Karnal, by judgment of conviction dated 04.03.2014 and order of sentence dated 05.03.2014, which have been upheld by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Karnal, on 26.09.2017,
