In pursuance to the order dated 06.12.2017, the parties had appeared before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and as per the report of the Mediator dated 15.02.2018, the matter has been settled.

As per the settlement, petitioner-Sanjeev Kumar has handed over an amount of Rs.50,000/- in cash which is paid to respondent-Lalit Kumar, who is present in Court and identified by his counsel.

The matter has been compromised between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre and the respondent has made a statement that he has no objection if the present revision petition filed by the petitioner is allowed; the judgment dated 26.10.2016 passed by the trial Court convicting the petitioner for an offence punishable under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act; order of sentence of even date vide which the petitioner was sentenced to undergo simple imprisonment for a period of one year and to pay a fine of Rs.5,000/- and in default of payment of fine to further undergo simple imprisonment for a period of two months and the judgment dated 25.09.2017 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, holding the conviction of the petitioner, is set aside.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. Judgment of conviction dated 26.10.2016 and order of sentence of even date as well as judgment dated 25.09.2017 are set aside, subject to payment of costs of Rs.5,000/- to be deposited with District Legal Services Authority, Ludhiana on or before 30.04.2018, failing which the revision petition filed by the petitioner shall be deemed to be dismissed without any further orders.

Copy of the order be sent to Chief Judicial Magistrate, Khanna, for compliance.
