Challenge in this civil writ petition is laid to the order dated 28.06.2013, Annexure P-1 passed by the respondent, vide which the petitioner has been compulsorily retired.

Learned counsel for the respondent, on instructions, states that the petitioner in fact, retired on 30.06.2013 on attaining age of superannuation. The petitioner had applied for extension and the same was declined, therefore, the expression “compulsorily retired” has been reflected which ought to have been recorded as “retired on attaining superannuation”.

The learned counsel for the respondent undertakes that the respondent shall issue another order with clarification after substituting the word “compulsorily retired” with “retired on attaining the age of superannuation” with effect from the same date and number.

In this view of the matter and the statement made, the intended purpose of the petition is fully achieved.

Consequently, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent to do the needful within four weeks from today. If the undertaking made at bar is not complied within the stipulated period, the petitioner shall have liberty to revive the present petition.
