On the last date of hearing, the contemner alongwith his counsel stated that he was a patient of diabetes and suffering from Cardio Vascular disease and Neurological problem and, therefore, he may be pardoned. Since the contemner pleaded for tendering apology, the Court was of the opinion that he be given a chance not to repeat conduct of creating ruckus in future and, accordingly, directed him to appear before Mr. Sumit Bhalla, Chief Judicial Magistrate, Tarn Taran and tender written apology before him besides pleading oral apology that he would never indulge in misconduct. It was further directed that he would file an affidavit

that he would not misbehave with any Presiding Officer of the Judicial Courts in future. Accordingly, Mr. Sumit Bhalla, Chief Judicial Magistrate, Tarn Taran was asked to submit a report and also about his satisfaction to the apology to be tendered by the contemner.

Pursuant to the above, report has been received from Mr. Sumit Bhalla, Chief Judicial Magistrate, Tarn Taran wherein he has mentioned that the contemner appeared in person and submitted application for tendering written apology. Alongwith the application, he submitted affidavit dated 29.10.2018 that he would not misbehave with any Judicial Officer in future. He also submitted a statement apologizing for his conduct in the Court and submitted that he would not indulge in such activities, like sending unwanted and unwarranted E-mails and messages on the personal and official phones of the Judicial Officers in future. He also tendered oral apology undertaking to remain peaceful in the Court during the proceedings of the trial. After the requisite apologies were tendered, Mr. Sumit Bhalla, Chief Judicial Magistrate, Tarn Taran submitted from the written apology tendered by the contemner whereby he undertook to maintain the dignity and decorum of the Court besides not to indulge in such like activities, he was satisfied about the apology tendered which according to him was genuine.

As the contemner has tendered apology by way of affidavit dated 29.10.2018 and also oral apology apologizing for his conduct and not to indulge in activities of sending unwanted and unwarranted E-mails in future besides sending messages on the personal and official phones of the Judicial Officers. The apology tendered by the contemner was found to be genuine and, accordingly, accepted by Mr. Sumit Bhalla, Chief Judicial Magistrate, Tarn Taran.

In view of the above, no further steps are required to be taken in the present petition. The rule is discharged.
