This revision petition is directed impugned order dated 05.05.2017 vide which the trial Court has dismissed the application moved by accused-convict that the complainant and her witness Rajeev Nagpal be made to undergo lie-detector test, narco-test and brain mapping test so as to clear the picture of the case.

I have gone through the impugned order. The reasoning given is there in para No.5 of that order. The trial Court in light of the law on the subject has come to the conclusion that the application was doomed for failure noting that no individual should be forcibly subjected to any of the technique and question.
