Both the petitioners by way of present writ petition have sought issuance of Writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to consider their case for compassionate appointment on priority basis being a special case as they are members of terrorist affected families and are also covered by the Govt. Instructions dated 28.05.2002, 18.06.2002 and 09.07.2008 (P-6 to P-8).

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that the present writ petition has become infructuous as both the petitioners have been given appointment.

Dismissed as infructuous.
