The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 401 Cr.P.C., against the order dated 27.02.2018, passed by the learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Ferozepur, dismissing his appeal against the order dated 16.01.2018, passed by the learned Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, Ferozepur, vide which the bail application of the petitioner has been dismissed.

It is alleged that 75 grams heroin, three Pakistani mobile phone SIMs, one Chinese pistol, 7 live cartridges and Rs.4,00,000/- were recovered from him.

The petitioner is a juvenile. He is in custody since 19.05.2017.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, the criminal revision petition is allowed and the applicant-appellant is admitted to bail, subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, Ferozepur/Duty Magistrate, Ferozepur.
