by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ajnala, on 10.09.2015 and the appeal preferred against the same having been dismissed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar, on 05.03.2018. A compromise has been entered into between the parties, which is acknowledged by the counsel for the complainant, who had appeared before this Court on 16.04.2018. Copy of the compromise has been appended as Annexure P-1 with the present petition.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that in the light of the compromise which has been entered into between the parties, the sentence of the petitioners be reduced to the one already undergone.

Counsel for respondents 2 and 3, the complainant and injured, states that he has no objection to the same.

Keeping in view the fact that a compromise has been entered into between the parties, the present petition is disposed of by upholding the order of conviction of the petitioners, however, the sentence of the petitioners is reduced to the period already undergone by them.

In the light of the disposal of the petition, CRM Nos.12852 and 12853 of 2018 stand disposed of as infructuous.
