Present revision is directed against the order framing of charge. It has been urged before the court that injury being simple in nature, offence under Section 307 IPC would not be attracted. Besides, petitioner could not have been identified as according to prosecution all came with muffled faces. I find no merit in the plea. At the stage of framing charge court has to see whether ingredients of the offence are made out or not. Mere fact that the assault made by the petitioner did not result in serious injury would not lead to the conclusion that offence under Section 307 IPC is not made out. Rest of the pleas raised by the petitioner are purely factual in nature. Petition appears to be totally frivolous. Same is dismissed with Rs.10,000/- as costs.
