Custody certificate filed by the State is taken on record.

This is an application filed under Section 397 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking suspension of sentence of the applicant/petitioner during the pendency of the appeal, who has been convicted and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment substantially for a period of 01 year under Sections 354, 451 of Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that the applicant/petitioner has already undergone a sentence of 04 months and 11 days, out of the substantial sentence of 01 year awarded to him, as per custody certificate dated 04.07.2018. It is further submitted that there is no other case pending against the applicant.

The revision is not likely to be heard in near future.

Hence, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the applicant has undergone major part of sentence, the application of the applicant/petitioner is accepted and the remaining sentence of the applicant/petitioner is suspended during the pendency of the revision, subject to his furnishing fresh bail bonds to the satisfaction of concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
