It was considering the submission made on behalf of the petitioner that he wanted to amicably resolve the entire dispute with the respondent-wife that the Court had issued notice of the application for condonation of delay subject to furnishing of receipt reflecting clearance of all arrears of maintenance before the Registry of the Court and the petitioner thereafter continuing paying a sum of ₹ 8000/- per month as assessed by impugned order dated 24.01.2018. Admittedly such conditions have not been complied with. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that mother of the petitioner is seriously ill. Resultantly the petitioner is unable to arrange funds to clear the arrears of maintenance and pay a sum of ₹ 8000/- per month. She has placed on file the supporting documents. The petitioner, who is present in Court, states that he would not be able to comply with the directions of the Court for the reason that he is unemployed and does not have any source of income. Reason may be any but since the terms and conditions on which notice of the application for condonation of delay was

issued, have not been complied with, the petition stands dismissed accordingly.
