Pursuant to the order dated 22.02.2018, Sh. Rajesh Ahuja, Special Power of Attorney holder has appeared in Court and stated that the matter has been compromised between the parties and entire payment has been made.

Since the parties have compromised and the cheque amount has been paid, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in custody. The offence is compoundable and the conviction can also be quashed on compounding of the offence.

In view of the above the present revision petition is allowed. The judgment of the Courts below are set aside subject to conviction of the petitioner being maintained and the sentence being reduced to the period already undergone. The bail and surety bonds furnished by the petitioner are discharged.
