This is a petition that has been filed seeking to challenge order dated 20.03.2018 whereby the trial Court has dismissed an application filed under Section 319 Cr.P.C seeking to summon additional accused.

During pendency of this petition, the matter stands compromised between the parties. In terms of the compromise arrived at between the parties, payment has to be made to the complainant as full and final settlement which would be inclusive of past, present and future maintenance alongwith permanent alimony and it is also agreed between the parties that a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act is to be filed as well.

Parties have submitted that a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act has already been filed and second motion is now pending in the month of May 2019. The balance payment would be received by the complainant on the date so fixed.

In view of the aforesaid position, no further orders are called for in the instant petition. Proceedings before the trial Court are stayed to enable the parties to adhere the terms and conditions of the compromise as also liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a petition for quashing of the said FIR.

In view of the compromise arrived at between the parties, present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such leaving it open to revive any of the proceedings in case terms and conditions are not adhered to.
