Present revision petition was filed against the judgment of conviction dated 09.11.2016 and order of sentence dated 10.11.2016 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Gurugram and judgment dated 13.12.2017 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Gurugram vide which the appeal was dismissed.
