Mr. Kanwaljeet Singh Derabassi, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-complainant Sham Lal and filed his Vakalatnam, which is taken on record. The respondent-complainant is also present in Court.

Learned counsel for the respondent has produced the original Adhar Card of the respondent-Sham Lal son of Kundan Lal, resident of C-783, Railway Road, Jalalabad, Fazilka and has also produced a photocopy of the Adhar Card. Respondent-complainant Sham Lal accepts the affidavit dated 22.11.2017 (Annexure P-1) to be executed by him acknowledging the fact that a compromise has been entered into between him and the petitioner and that he has received an amount of ₹1,70,000/- as full and final settlement with regard to the dispute and in discharge of legal liabilities, which the petitioner would have towards the respondent-complainant.

In view of the compromise entered between the parties, the conviction of the petitioner is upheld and his sentence is reduced to the extent of the deposit of ₹5,000/- with the Legal Services Authority, Punjab within a period of one week from today as fine.

Criminal Revision stands disposed of accordingly.
