Notice in the application.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Deepali Puri, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete copy of the paper book has been furnished to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

Heard.

During the course of arguments, learned counsel for the applicant submits that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case she is allowed to participate in the process of selection.

Learned State counsel states that the candidature of the

petitioner could be considered in case she is eligible in all respects.

Keeping in view the above, with the consent of the parties, the main petition is taken on today's Board.

Main Case

By way of the present petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to allow the petitioner to continue on the post of lecturer on which she had been appointed and not to replace her by another set of similar temporary lecturer.

In view of the above submissions, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner provisionally. In case, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the petitioner is not eligible for consideration, then a speaking order be passed in the matter.

The petitioner shall be at liberty either to revive the present petition or file afresh.
